

# Julie FAQs

Housebroken?	Julie is fully housebroken.
Medical Problems?	Julie tested positive for heartworm when she arrived at GRREAT. She has been treated for heartworm, but needs a follow-up test in about 4 months (end-June).
Good with people and other dogs?	Julie loves to be with people. She loves being petted and having her tummy rubbed. She gets along great with our other Golden, but we have noticed that she will growl defensively when confronted by an in-your-face dog, or by a pack of dogs as in a dog park. We think she should overcome this fear.
Good with children and cats?	No firsthand experience. We suspect she would be okay with both.
Obedience trained?	Julie does not appear to have formal obedience training, but <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Will “sit” on command</li><li>○ Does not pull on the leash while walking.</li><li>○ Does not jump up on people.</li></ul>
Crate trained?	She can be crated, but does not particularly like it. She LOVES to curl up on the couch.
Activity level?	Medium. We had to keep her on a low-activity level because of her heartworm treatment.
Phobias?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ No experience with fireworks or thunderstorms.</li><li>○ She is not afraid of noises from lawn mowers, power tools, vacuum cleaners and the like.</li></ul>
Toys	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Julie likes to chew on Nylabones. She is not terribly interested in most other toys ... unless our other dog is playing with them!</li><li>○ She sleeps in a doggie bed, although she has tried to sneak into our bed during the night.</li></ul>
Chewing problem?	No.
Okay in cars?	Julie does okay, but tends to want to jump into the front seat.
Needs fenced yard?	Yes.
